### **Major Activities:**

Attend 1-2 RHHSA meetings to provide feedback and input on ongoing activities (let us know if you are

- If you do not yet have your clearances, please begin the process ASAP. Thank you.
- If you are not a member of RHHSA yet, please join ASAP as membership is requested for all Reps who serve in this role.
- Be sure to coordinate timing of parties and/or donation request (i.e. young author breakfast) with the teacher.

### **Administrative Considerations:**

- You are strongly encouraged to visit the <a href="www.rhhsa.org/leadership">www.rhhsa.org/leadership</a> page to access the various resources there including the: food allergy list, HR rep job description, etc.
- We will provide you a roster for your class and you will be granted access to send group emails to your class via our My School Anywhere online directory. Instructions will be online at our leadership site.
- Each class gets up to \$15 per party to support craft or game supplies. Reimbursements must be submitted via our online form: http://www.rhhsa.org/budget. We request that requests are 1) within in one week of the actual event; 2) all at once (submit all related receipts within same request) and 3) by one person. Food and/or drink items can be requested via donations from the class.
- We strongly encourage classes within grades to coordinate and work together as appropriate to ensure parity across grades (i.e. one 2<sup>nd</sup> grade class does not have a 50-minute party with favors, games and crazy snacks while the other 2<sup>nd</sup> grade class has pretzels and a themed coloring page)
- If you have more than 1 HR Representative or people who have volunteered to help out, please work out amongst yourself who is doing what. Please note only 1-2 people are allowed to be in the classroom to "host" class parties & they must have their clearances. Please inform the teacher who will be on site.
